Brine Leas School is an 11-18, mixed, comprehensive Academy within the Cornovii Trust. Located in the beautiful market town of Nantwich, we are within easy reach of the conurbations of the midlands and northwest of England.

We are a popular and successful school with a strong commitment to a broad curriculum that meets the needs of all our pupils. CAD/CAM and a range of ICT packages are used to enhance the technology area along with a range of practical tasks.

The department is located on the ground floor with purpose-built CAD/CAM room with P.C.'s. It also has a Textiles/Graphics room with P.C.'s and sewing machines including CAD/CAM. There is an Engineering workshop with linked Heat treatment area, a separate Electronics/DT workshop, a multi-purpose workshop and two separate Food areas. All rooms have either an Interactive Whiteboard or a projector linked to a laptop. In the Art block we have three specialists' rooms, including a Ceramics room, two kilns and an extensive gallery space which exhibits work from across the department.

Art and Food are compulsory for all students in key stage three. In Year 7 and 8 there is one rotation a year for Design and Technology subjects allowing all students to experience the different disciplines. In Year 9, all students choose three technology options in preparation for options into year 10. Design and Technology courses at key stage 4 comprise of Art, Ceramics, Creative iMedia (Graphics) Cambridge National Certificate, Design Technology, Engineering Tech Award (WJEC), and Engineering Programmable Systems OCR, Food Preparation and Nutrition, Art & Design Textiles. Key Stage 5 qualifications comprise of Art, Engineering, Electronics, Food, Graphics, Photography, Product Design and Textiles.

At Key Stage 5 the department has two purpose-built workshops, one with a focus on Product Design with a number CAD/CAM machines and the other on Textiles and Electronics. The department also has a separate classroom for Photography and Graphics.

We offer a full and high-quality induction programme, including the Early Career Framework for ECTs.
