About the school

The current school opened in October 1988 and was extended in September 2012. The main building has had significant building works undertaken and this included the installation of a new fire alarm system as well as having a large part of the roof replaced. The school is on two sites and the Annexe building is situated opposite the main school. This building houses our Reception and year one class and also underwent a schedule of improvement during 2021-22. A privately owned nursery and pre-school share the Annexe site. Hoppers was opened in 2005 and as well as offering nursery provision also runs wrap around care in the form of a before and after school club. Alsager Highfields is fortunate to have extensive school grounds which include; a sports field, an astroturf pitch, an outdoor classroom, play areas, a pond and a woodland area.

The philosophy of the school is to ensure that all children are nurtured and encouraged to be the very best they can be. We strive for our pupils to leave our care as well-rounded individuals with a thirst for learning, who are fully equipped to start the next phase of their education. The school joined AMAT in September 2020 and has recently become part of the Cornovii Trust (September 2022), which consists of Alsager High School, Alsager Highfields, Audlem St James primary School, Brine Leas High school and Weston Primary School. Our most recent Ofsted inspection in March 2023 rated the school as Good.

Alsager Highfields is situated in the heart of Alsager and as such is a school that prides itself on developing and maintaining community links. We currently have 207 pupils on roll and live our motto 'Nurture, Believe, Achieve' so that all our children are able to flourish.

Overall purpose of the job:

The post is based at Alsager Highfields Primary school. Previous cleaning experience would be extremely beneficial but appropriate induction and training will be provided when in post.

Principal Responsibilities:

- 1** Undertake cleaning, washing, sweeping, vacuum cleaning, emptying of litter bins, polishing and dusting of the designated areas (which may include toilets and shower area) and fixtures and fittings, using where appropriate, powered equipment.
- 2** Undertake deep cleans in the school holidays, including the cleaning down of furniture, cupboards, cut back, floors stripped, resealed and polished.

- 3 To ensure the safeguarding of our students is at the core of all aspects of the role. To keep up to date with any additional new guidance or training brought to your attention by the Designated Safeguarding Lead.
- 4 Fulfil the responsibilities outlined under the school's Health and Safety Policy and share responsibility for your own safety and that of students and colleagues.
- 5 Undertake relevant training to keep up to date with the school's policies and procedures.
- 6 Uphold the aims and objectives of the school and ensure these are reflected in your work.

Notwithstanding the detail in this outline, in accordance with the TCT's flexibility policy the Jobholder will undertake such work as may be determined by the Headteacher from time to time, up to or at a level consistent with the Principal Responsibilities of the job.
